### Giving Glances Spotlight: KidSight – Changing Lives One Look at a Time

Imagine a child starting school, full of curiosity and potential—yet struggling to learn, not because they lack ability, but because they simply can't see clearly. Vision problems can quietly limit a child's development, and by the time they're noticed, it may

already be too late. That's why the Lions KidSight program matters so



For nearly a decade, our dedicated volunteers from the regional Lions Clubs have been delivering free, handsfree vision screenings to children across Manitoba and Northwestern Ontario. From infants as young as six months old to teenagers, this quick and gentle screening only takes seconds, but it can change the course of a child's life.

Our teams bring this life-changing service directly into daycares, schools, and public events, using advanced screening cameras that detect signs of serious conditions like amblyopia, strabismus, cataracts, and even eye cancer—often before any symptoms are visible.

Just one screening can make the difference between a future of missed opportunities and a lifetime of clear, confident learning.

One of our recent screenings, the Tiny Tots event, was specifically designed for children aged 2–5. Thanks to the care and compassion of our volunteers, dozens of little ones now have a clearer path ahead—and their families have peace of mind.

To every Lion and volunteer who lends their time to this incredible program: thank you. Your kindness helps kids see a brighter world—and that's a gift beyond measure.
